Dear Parents / Caregivers

Tauriko School has been involved with Mathletics since 2008 when senior classes first began using it as a tool for learning. In 2011 the whole school were involved in the programme as it proved to be very valuable and popular in terms of how quickly students developed and enhanced their mathematical skills and mental arithmetic. In addition, students of all ages and ability levels became very motivated to complete a variety of tasks and on-line challenges regularly. The programme covers a wide range of mathematical concepts with new ideas and challenges being developed all the time that are in line with the New Zealand Mathematics Curriculum.

3P Learning (Mathletics) is constantly updating its service, product and on-line capability.

Due to the success and relevance of the programme each year, all students from Years 1 - 8 will again be involved next year in Mathletics as part of their class maintenance programmes. The licence will be for 1 year; it is accessible 24 hours, 7 days a week and comes at a price of just \$20.00 per student. **Payment for Mathletics will need to be received by Friday 21 February 2014, in order for students to access this learning tool.**

It is a great opportunity for students to take part in the challenging, motivating Mathletics programme at home and school.

All students are expected to be part of the Mathletics programme, there will be in-class support and advice which can be continued and followed up at home. Students are able to access aspects of the programme that link to their learning needs.

The programme has proven hugely popular with the students (and parents) and is great motivation for developing and improving those basic facts and number skills as well as following up on current maths learning from the classroom.
