As you are aware the schools' Board of Trustees has been working through a process to establish an Enrolment Scheme (School Zone) for Tauriko School due to the growth of the school. The school has consulted with local schools and its community around a draft enrolment scheme. Feedback was then sent to the MOE to consider and MOE staff met with the Board this week to discuss this and gather the Board's thoughts around the feedback.

The Ministry of Education have made the final decision on the school enrolment scheme and details of this are on our [school website](#). Pre-enrolments are due in by noon next Friday 26 June for out-of-zone students. An advertisement is in the local Bay of Plenty Times newspaper Friday 19 June.

It is also important that families who wish to enrol students who live in zone contact the school office to ensure we are aware of this. This helps us as a school to plan for how many out-of-zone enrolments we advertise each term. For the next few terms we will advertise each term for the following term's enrolments to manage this in a timely manner

Please notify any families who you feel might be interested in attending Tauriko School next term who are out of zone.

A huge thank you to all those members of our school community who took the time to support the Board with your feedback on the draft enrolment scheme. This feedback was important in supporting the Board in their discussions with the Ministry of Education.
